The ASCE East Central Branch (ASCE ECB) is proud to announce the ASCE ECB Scholarship. ASCE ECB is committed to supporting Central Florida's brightest minds for their future careers in civil, construction, and environmental engineering.

Eligibility

This scholarship is open to undergraduate freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors and graduate students who meet the following criteria:

- Currently registered full-time student majoring in Civil/Construction/Environmental Engineering at a university in the East Central Branch region with continued enrollment in Fall 2022 semester.
- Is an active member of his/her local ASCE student chapter
- Is currently in good academic standing (2.8 overall GPA or higher)

Requirements

The following items will need to be turned in with the Scholarship packet no later than **April 29th, 2022** for eligibility:

- Career goals essay demonstrating interest in Civil, Construction, and Environmental engineering (**500 words**)
- Unofficial school Transcripts
- 3 references with names and phone numbers (Ex – Faculty, Employers, Coworkers, ASCE Student-Chapter Officer (1 required))
- Must be present at ASCE officer installation on the last week of September to receive scholarship (scholarship recipients receive free registration to event)

Scoring

Applications will be scored using the following criteria:

- Essay (originality, grammar, spelling, punctuation)
- GPA
- Involvement with ASCE Student Chapter (To be verified by ASCE Student-Chapter Officer)
- Extracurricular and community involvement activities

Application Process

Applicants should submit electronically a complete application package to thomas.anzelone@rsandh.com (no later than 04/29/2022). **No other methods** of submission will be accepted.

Amount of Scholarship(s)

ASCE Florida Section East Central Branch will award a minimum of one \$1,000 undergraduate scholarship and more depending on the number of applications received. The award may be given to one or multiple students depending on the quality of the applications received.

The East Central Branch will also award the **ECB Legacy Endowment Scholarship** to the top applicant with the highest ranked application per scoring criteria.

- Attach sheet with 3 references
- Attach sheet with list of extracurricular and community involvement activities
