



2025 Scholarship Application

The ASCE East Central Branch (ASCE ECB) is proud to announce the ASCE ECB Scholarship. ASCE ECB is committed to supporting Central Florida's brightest minds for their future careers in civil, construction, and environmental engineering.

Eligibility

This scholarship is open to undergraduate freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors and graduate students who meet the following criteria:

- Currently registered full-time student majoring in Civil/Construction/Environmental Engineering at a university in the East Central Branch region with continued enrollment in Fall 2025 semester.
- Is an active member of his/her local ASCE student chapter
- Is currently in good academic standing (2.8 overall GPA or higher)

Requirements

A completed application shall be submitted no later than **April 25th, 2025** and must include:

- A completed application form
- A short (no more than **500 words**) essay describing why you chose to pursue a degree in civil/construction/environmental engineering, or your journey of your college career and what you impacts have you had up to this point.
- Unofficial school Transcripts with GPA Highlighted
- 3 references with names and phone numbers (Ex – Faculty, Employers, Coworkers, ASCE Student-Chapter Officer (1 required))
- Preferred – recipient shall be present at ASCE officer installation in September 2025 to receive scholarship (scholarship recipients receive free registration to event)

Scoring

Applications will be scored using the following criteria:

- Essay (originality, grammar, spelling, punctuation)
- GPA
- Involvement with ASCE Student Chapter (To be verified by ASCE Student-Chapter Officer)
- Extracurricular and community involvement activities

Application Process

Applicants should submit electronically a complete application package to daynaduffy.asce@gmail.com (no later than 4/25/2025). **No other methods** of submission will be accepted.

Amount of Scholarship(s)

ASCE Florida Section East Central Branch will award up to \$7,200 in scholarships depending on the number of applications received. The award may be given to one or multiple students depending on the quality of the applications received.

The East Central Branch will also award the **ECB Legacy Endowment Scholarship** to the top applicant with the highest ranked application per scoring criteria.
