- Unofficial school transcripts
- One (1) letter of recommendation from a faculty member of the school you are currently attending.
- Full Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- List any involvement with ASCE Student Chapter, other engineering student groups, and other community involvement / service activities on separate page(s)
