ELIGIBILITY

- Is currently in good academic standing (2.8 overall GPA or higher)

REQUIREMENTS

This following items will need to be submitted with this Scholarship packet no later than **November 1, 2019** for eligibility:

- Career goals essay demonstrating interest in Civil Engineering (**no more than 250 words**)
- Unofficial school Transcripts
- Resume
- Three references with name, title, phone number, and email address (EX: Faculty member, Employer, Coworker, ASCE Student Chapter Officer)

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Applications will be scored using the following criteria:

- Essay (originality, grammar, spelling, punctuation)
- GPA and coursework
- Resume (Presentation & Content)
- Involvement with ASCE Student Chapter (to be verified by ASCE Student Chapter Officer)
- Feedback from references (as necessary)

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applicants shall submit electronically a complete application package to Sam Bowyer at Samuel.Bowyer@ms.com in PDF format (**no later than 11/01/2019**). **No other methods** of submission will be accepted.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The ASCE ECB T&DI will award one (1) \$1,000 academic scholarships. The recipients of the scholarships will be notified by November 15, 2019. The award will be presented to the winning student at an ASCE ECB TD&I Luncheon on December 9, 2019. Please make arrangements to attend this luncheon if you are selected.
